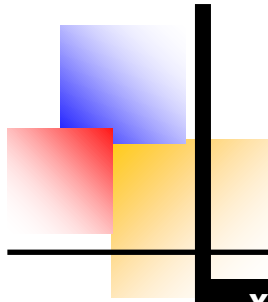


## 7. RAJAB - 1431 A.H.

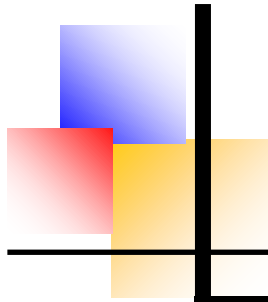

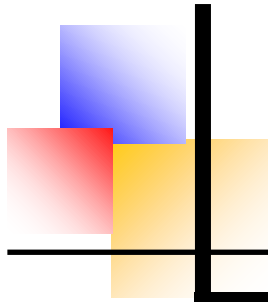


## 10. SHAWWAL - 1431 A.H.

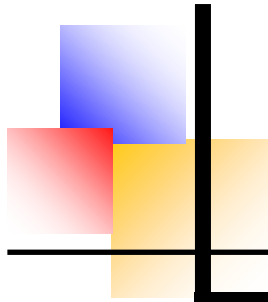


## 11. DHUL-QADAH - 1431 A.H.

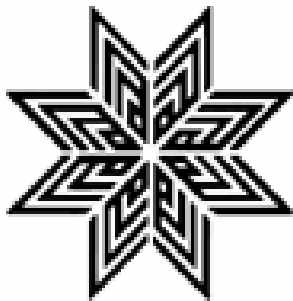
