Conducted by Andrea Brown, Director of Music at Morley College, the choir has performed in some of the capital's most prestigious choral venues, including Westminster Abbey and Temple Church, London.

Pandemonium is a choir of young adults who perform regular concerts in both community settings and venues such as St John's Smith Square and the Queen Elizabeth Hall amongst others.

Following a sold-out concert by ICE at Cadogan Hall in 2010, **Expressions from the Abrahamic Traditions** promises to be an unmissable and enlightening experience.
